

HOT WORK PERMIT

Any activities that involve the use of portable gas or arc welding equipment, or involve soldering, grinding or any other similar activities producing flames, a spark or heat requires a hot work permit.

The permit is delivered considering that the below mentioned requirements are respected.

Safety of hot work depends, first and foremost, on the ship's captain and crew.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS / REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST

- Cutting and/or welding equipment shall be inspected and found in good order
- Ready to use portable fire extinguisher must be located at the working area
- Fire watch shall be maintained continuously during and for at least a full hour following completion
- Fire hoses shall be installed and ready to use on deck at all times during hot work and fire watch period
- Telephone with PSO phone number shall be available at all time during hot work
- Floors must be swept clean and found free of combustible and flammable materials prior to hot work
- Combustible and flammable materials shall be stored at least 15 meters (50 ft) away from hot work location
- Fire shields shall be installed on combustible floors (Fire retardant plywood, flame-proof, tarpaulin, etc.)
- No hot work while bunkering vessel
- Hot work permit shall be posted at hot work location and all workers should be aware of requirements

When working on enclosed equipment:

- Enclosed vessels and piping must be emptied and purged of combustible and flammable materials and gasses.
